Purpose: Bylaws - Article 2: PA Nonbelievers is a nonprofit organization created to foster a community of atheists, agnostics and secular humanists dedicated to improving the human condition through rational inquiry and creative thinking unfettered by superstition, religion or any form of dogma. PA Nonbelievers is a local partner of American Atheists Inc, an affiliate of Atheist Alliance International and works in full cooperation with the Council for Secular Humanism and the Council for Secular Humanism

Article 4: Members, Section 1: General membership in the organization shall be open to all persons adherent to the purpose of Article 2 of the bylaws.

Calendar Year 2015 memberships will expire January 1st, 2016 at 12:01am unless full dues are received by that time. Calendar year 2016 memberships will expire January 1st, 2017. Membership shall include the right to vote at annual membership meetings and special membership meetings in addition to receiving the organization's newsletter "PANVIEWS" in the form of Email.

The Board of Directors must approve all applications for membership and renewals. Members may run for director positions, when available, at our annual meeting. Our officers are selected by our board of directors, in order to serve as an officer you must have been a member for 6 months.

Although not a requirement for board membership, it is highly recommended directors be able to receive and respond to emails every day since a large volume of PAN business is conducted via e-mail.

Members may attend the scheduled monthly Board of Directors meetings upon request, to just observe or to offer suggestions and ideas, but do not have voting privileges at that time. Meeting Minutes and complete Bylaws will be available free of charge upon request, to any current member.
